
who are not only welcomed by locals but are also vital to the town's economy and businesses.


East Winds















The Tree

circa 1800 - 2024

By 1896, the Californian Monterey Pine at Woodcot was already a mature tree which dominated the extensive gardens. Aaron Murch, the gardener, loved the tree so much that he grew many saplings from it which were planted around South Sands and East Portlemouth, which can be spotted to this day.

For generations of visitors the sight of the majestic Woodcot pine tree has signalled that the holiday has begun.

In one direction, the lure of the town with its sweets in pink striped bags, ice creams, and welcoming pubs and restaurants. In the other, the enchantment of the high walls with the stone bridge spanning the road. Beyond it, the view of the estuary and sea opens, promising


freedom, fresh air, barbecues and picnics, as well as magical walks through hidden valleys and blustery cliff tops.

All lovers of Salcombe were saddened by the necessary felling of the tree in the autumn of 2024. The rotten trunk and diseased roots finally condemned it, as it had become a danger to life and property. However, the memories of happy


majestic pine, have endured for over one hundred years.





Malcolm Darch, a master shipwright and maritime historian, has spent 50 years crafting exquisite model ships from his workshop overlooking Salcombe Harbour. His scale reproductions, renowned for their precision and artistry, are prized by collectors, museums, and businesses worldwide, fetching thousands of pounds.

Beyond model-making, Malcolm is a respected historian with significant publications to his name. His workshop doubles as a treasure trove of maritime artifacts, reflecting his deep passion for naval heritage. Honoured as a Fellow of the Society for Nautical Research, he is a leading figure in preserving Britain's seafaring legacy.

Malcolm's latest masterpiece, a model of the ill-fated Herzogin Cecilie, wrecked near Salcombe in 1936, will be finished in April. His latest book is currently in production and will be available in 2026.







FOUR FAVOURITE WALKS



EAST SOAR TO BOLT HEAD

From shipwrecks to wildlifespotting, discover the dramatic coast around Salcombe on this circular walk via the South West Coast Path. After the jagged rocks at Bolt Head, wander down to the impossibly blue waters of Starehole Bay, then return past Overbeck's, with views of the Salcombe Estuary.

EAST SOAR RANGER RUN

This circular trail run dips and climbs along rugged cliffs where 'Dartmoor meets the sea'. A wild, partially tamed landscape with views of the Atlantic ocean, sandy beaches and farm land. Overhead raptors fly, and long-horned Highland cattle peacefully munch on the rich grassland.

PRAWLE POINT WALK


This walk is full of drama: heart thumping clifftop climbs, with rocky raised beaches below. Look out for the sunken Demetrios below Signalhouse Point and don't miss the ancient boundary stones that dot the landscape.

WALK TO SNAPES POINT

Enjoy a short walk through the South Hams countryside, between fields teeming with wildlife, until you arrive at Snapes Point, which offers panoramic views of Salcombe and the Kingsbridge Estuary.
